#### PAYMENT, FINANCING, AND FUNDING

**Disbursements:** Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's fee: This is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium: This is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Newspaper notices: These are charges for death notices placed in newspapers outlets.

*Municipal death registration fee:* This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

**Payment:** A deposit is required: Disbursements, H.S.T. and 30 % of services and merchandise. Balance is due within 60 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, Visa or MasterCard. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5% which is equivalent to 18% per annum.

**Funding:** For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death. Payment and financing options are available upon request.

**Trust:** You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

**Insurance:** You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled.

If you are pre-paying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.
